Benefits of a New & Larger Multipurpose Facility

The new facility is more than double the size of our current Fr. Fleming Hall and will accommodate for larger events. Listed are just some of the advantages of this facility:

- Will be able to have Masses on Sundays accommodating 1000 people.
- Less traffic congestion and more seating room for Easter and Christmas Masses.
- Better accommodate for larger fundraising events.
- Be able to host Sacramental Celebrations.
- CYO Will have space for two basketball courts allowing for more home games.
- Will have the opportunity to rent out the facility for large community events.
- Ample parking, with four times the number of parking spaces of what we currently have.

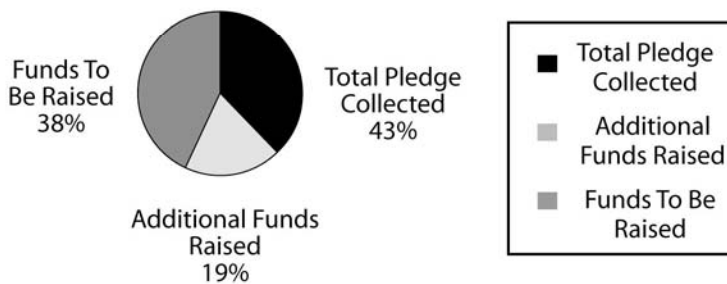
